#### **Description:**

In this workshop we'll be constructing two geometric patterns with a ruler and compass. The first, known as a 'double seed of life' is a beautiful pattern in its own right. However, it also serves as a grid upon which to draw a second pattern – a stunning mandala of spiralling squares.

You'll work alongside me as I demonstrate the process step-by-step. I'll also share some ideas for decorating your patterns, and will demonstrate how to outline them using a pen in your compass.

#### **Materials Required:**

- A drawing compass, ideally with a pen holder attachment
- A ruler, a pencil and an eraser
- A surface to press on, such as a cutting mat or the back of a sketchpad

## And after the session, for decorating and adding colour, you may wish to have:

- A colouring medium of your choice (e.g. paints, watercolour pencils, coloured pencils, marker pens, paint pens)
- A metallic, or other, pen to outline your pattern
- At least two sheets of good quality cartridge or sketch pad paper, A4 or even better, A3 size
